CAFÉ Project

The people we help at CAFÉ often have complex needs. These issues often only become apparent once our relationship with the client develops.

Interventions include help with housing, employment, training, benefits and debt as well as accessing services such as substance misuse and domestic abuse support.

St Giles can also help with issues around family mediation and support in discussions with schools.

Caseloads are deliberately kept low so each caseworker can provide intensive, flexible support to their clients and fill any gaps that are left by other services.

This also provides the client with a single point of contact who can then act as a broker to liaise with other agencies on the clients' behalf.

In 2009, CAFÉ won a national Charity Award for excellence.
